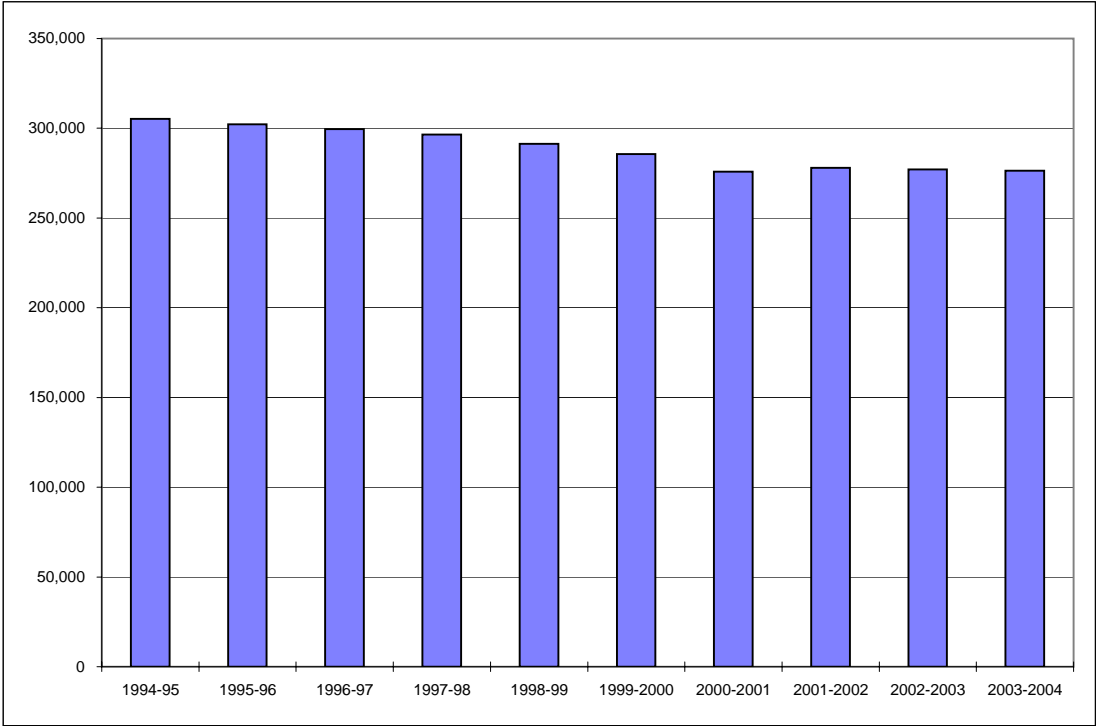

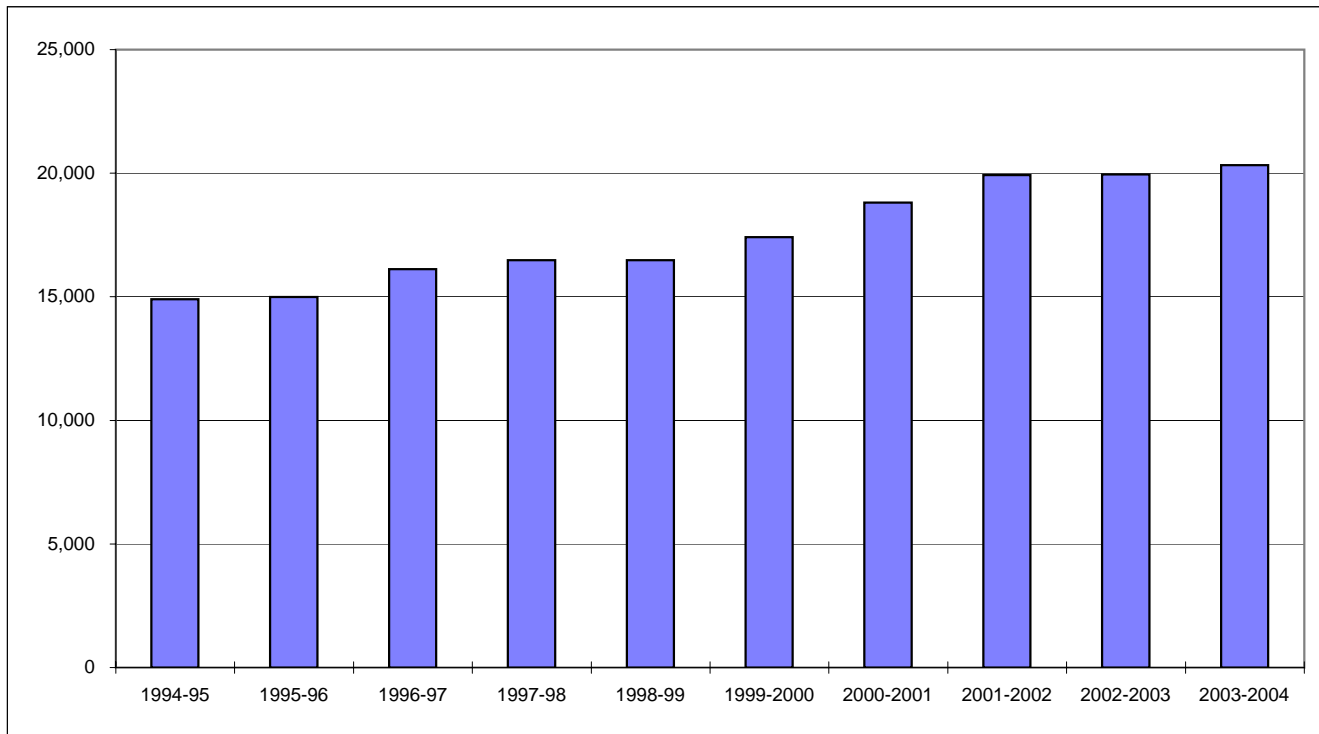
Ten Year History of West Virginia Membership by Grade
